From 1 October 2020, all horses, donkeys and ponies in England must be microchipped



The law applies to all equines regardless of age - you could face prosecution and a fine if you do not microchip before the deadline

Microchipping increases the chances of an equine being reunited with its owner if lost or stolen. It is also a permanent link between an equine and its passport

If your horse, donkey or pony has already been microchipped, update your details via the online Digital Stable
