Vet Gateway website – Content Migration Complete

Date issued: 13th May 2025

Purpose

1. To inform all Official Veterinarians (OVs), Food Competent Certifying Officers (FCCOs) and Animal Health Paraprofessionals (AHPs) that the migration of all content from the Vet Gateway website to a replacement hosting website is now complete.

Location of Instructions

2. The migrated content can now be found on GOV.UK, the [Improve International OV](#) and [Improve International AHP](#) websites or the [Tableau Public](#) website.
3. All pages on the Vet Gateway website have been updated with links which will redirect you to the migrated content.
4. Links to the migrated content are also available on the [Vets: guidance, forms and services](#) GOV.UK page.

Actions

5. The Vet Gateway website will remain in place until Friday 30th May 2025. After this time the website will be decommissioned and will be no longer available for use, with the relevant redirects in place.
6. OVS, FCCOs and AHPs are advised to replace any saved favourite links for Vet Gateway content with the new links to the moved content on GOV.UK, Improve International or Tableau Public.
