

## **APHA Briefing Note 25/25**

# Extension of the Groupage Export Facilitation Scheme

Date issued: 27 June 2025

## **Purpose**

To inform Official Veterinarians (OVs) and Food Competent Certifying Officers (FCCOs) about the extension of the Groupage Export Facilitation Scheme (GEFS).

## **Background**

The GEFS facilitates exports from approved food business operators by using 30-day Support Attestations to help in the certification process. The scheme was previously scheduled to close on 31 December 2025.

#### Information

- 1. Defra has been developing the GEFS over the past couple of years, with input from members, OVs and FCCOs, to make it as robust as possible before a decision is made on its future.
- 2. Defra can now confirm that the decision has been made to extend the GEFS.
- 3. Defra also confirms that there is an assumption that the GEFS will not be needed once the new arrangements of the proposed SPS agreement between the UK and EU are in place.
- Defra has communicated this decision to all current members of the GEFS.
- 5. As a reminder, the scheme will continue on the terms set out in the <u>revised</u> guidance issued last month. The guidance will apply from 1 August 2025.

- 8. Finally, based on member feedback, Defra will also publish an updated version of the Support Attestation PDFs that allow users to strike through text electronically. Note that the content will not change and that Support Attestations should not be edited to add to, delete or alter the standardised text.

#### Action

 OVs and FCCOs may continue to make use of the GEFS to facilitate exports until further notice.
